#### **PROCEDURES**

1. Apply for Entry Permission 14 working days before planned departure via MYEntry or MyTravelPass website.

(Exit & Return)

- 2. Must have a valid work permit before applying for Entry Permission. Applications for work permits to be submitted to the Immigration Department Malaysia via ESD online system.
- 3. The decision for the application will be made within **3 working days** from the receipt of a complete application.
- 4. Business travellers will receive a formal digital notification of the Entry Permission approval letter.
- 5.1st PCR test 3 days prior to departure at home country.
- 6. Complete Letter of Understanding and indemnity.
- 7.2nd PCR/RTK-Ag test on Day 1 of arrival.
- 8. Stay at the designated lounge or hotel until the release of the result.
- 9. Undergo mandatory quarantine of 10 days or 7 days (if tested negative within 72 hours before arrival).

11.3rd RTK-Ag test on Day 13 of arrival.

- 10. Shall adhere to the SOPs and NADMA's regulations.

- 1. Submit an application for **Entry Permission** with detailed itinerary 14 working days before planned departure via the MYEntry website.
- 2. No requirement for work permit before applying for Entry Permission
- 3. The decision for the application will be made within 3 working days from the receipt of completed application.
- 4. Business travellers will receive a formal digital notification of the Entry Permission approval letter.
- 5. Make necessary payment at least 3 working days before departure.
- 6.1st PCR test 3 days prior to **departure** at home country.
- 7. Complete Letter of Understanding and indemnity.
- 8.2nd PCR test on **Day 1 of arrival.**
- 9. No mandatory quarantine.
- 10. Shall adhere to the SOPs and the approved itinerary.
- 11. Liaison Officer to follow business travellers throughout the controlled itinerary.
- 12.3rd PCR test 3 days before departure.
