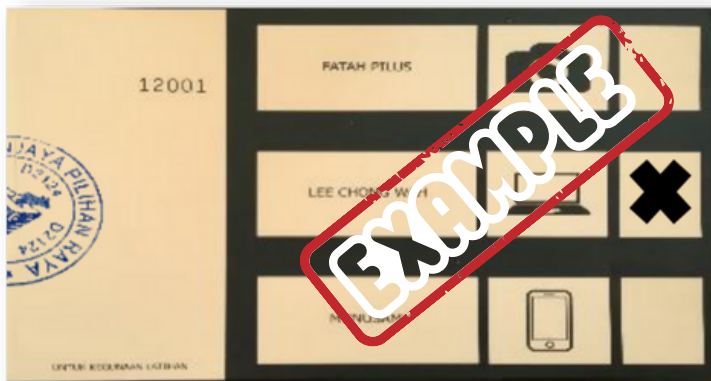

YOU ARE **NOT ALLOWED** TO WEAR, HOLD OR CARRY ANY ITEMS THAT BEARS A PARTY LOGO INTO THE POLLING STATION OR WITHIN 50 METERS OF THE POLLING STATION. YOU ARE ADVISED TO DRESS IN DECENT ATTIRE WHEN GOING OUT TO VOTE.

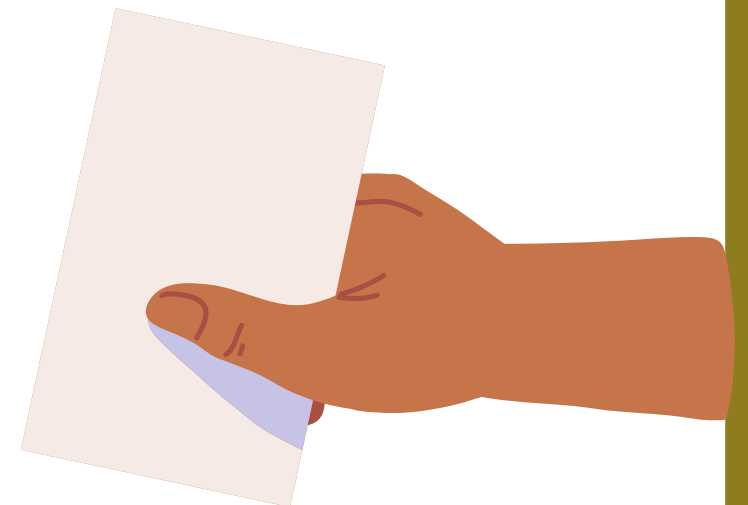

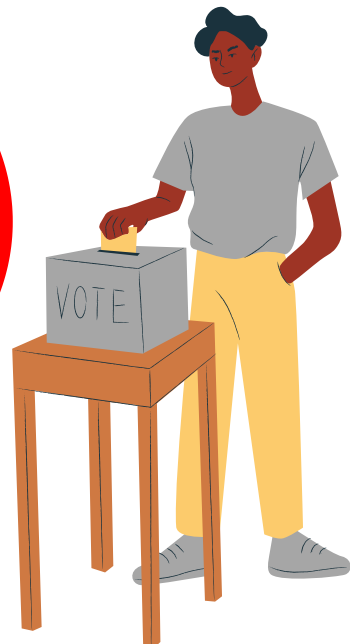

7 AFTER CASTING YOUR BALLOT, YOU ARE **NOT ALLOWED** TO LOITER AROUND THE POLLING STATION.



8 YOU ARE **NOT ALLOWED** TO TAKE PHOTOS INSIDE THE POLLING STATION AND OF YOUR BALLOT PAPER.

YOU MUST SURRENDER YOUR MOBILE PHONES TO THE PRESIDING OFFICER AS YOU COLLECT YOUR BALLOT PAPERS TO VOTE.

9 YOU **SHOULD NOT GIVE, ACCEPT OR TAKE** ANY FOOD, DRINKS OR REFRESHMENTS BEING OFFERED BY STRANGERS BEFORE, DURING OR AFTER THE VOTING PROCESS THAT CAN INFLUENCE YOUR VOTE TO AVOID COMMITTING AN OFFENCE OF TREATING.
