# MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER (MCO)

## MAJLIS KESELAMATAN NEGARA GENERAL STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES AS OF 19 FEBRUARY 2021

### MOVEMENT CONTROL

- No interstate or inter-district travels (according to the district borders set by the State Government).
- Number of passengers in private vehicles according to the capacity of the vehicle for the purpose of obtaining health or medical care, food supply, medicine, dietary supplements, basic & daily necessities in the same district as their residence or the district closest to their residence if there is no supply of said necessities in said area.
- For traveling back and forth to the workplace - according to the capacity of the vehicle.
- Interstate travel is allowed for long-distance married couples with prior permission and approval from PDRM.

### MOVEMENT CONTROL: EDUCATION & EXAMINATIONS

- Students and candidates sitting for SPM in 2020 and 2021, STPM, SVM, STAM, SKM, DVM, Assessment Admission to Special Schools (for Form 1 and Form 4), and equivalent international examinations are allowed to attend schools across the MCO/CMCO/RMCO areas. \*Movement can be accompanied by 1 guardian
- Lecturers/teachers/teaching staff for examination classes are allowed with the relevant Ministry's approval.
- Matriculation colleges are allowed. Students in boarding schools/universities/institutions are allowed to be there and to continue hybrid learning.
- International examinations, professional bodies, and research activities that require laboratory facilities in Institutions of Higher Education are allowed.

**Members of State Legislative Assemblies and Parliament** are allowed to travel across respective districts and states for official purposes or for visitation.

Number of people allowed in **vehicles transporting goods as well as economic/industrial activity chains** depends on the commercial vehicle registration license.

### WORKSITE CAPACITY

- All economic and business sectors approved by the relevant Ministries/Agencies can operate during the MCO period. Employee movement is subject to registration/operation approval letter and employee pass/employer confirmation letter.
- Attendance capacity of employees for the civil service is based on the Public Service Department (JPA) Circular/Instruction.
- The private sector is based on 30% Management and number of operating/support employees is set by the employer.

### DAY CARE CENTRES

- Childcare centres, nurseries, kindergartens, disabled (OKU), elderly, and women daycare centres are allowed to operate with the approval of the relevant Ministries/Agencies.
- Parents/guardians are allowed to send their children to daycare centres based on the capacity of the vehicle.

### CREATIVE INDUSTRY

- Studio recording activities for music, concerts, film making, talk shows and such similar activities are permitted limited to within the particular MCO area with the total crew members kept to a minimum and with no live audiences. The SOP for Creative Industry must be complied with.

### SPORTS & RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES

- Activities without physical contact carried out in open and enclosed areas by way of training for the purposes of health, fitness, and self-skills are permitted with a mandatory distance of 1-3 metres between participants.
- Operation of enclosed and semi-enclosed facilities/premises to be under constant supervisory control during operating hours.
- The existing quarantine-based centralised training program carried out by the National Sports Council and States Sports Council can continue under the concept of "Camp Quarantine-Based Training". Accommodation, Movement, and Training of athletes must strictly adhere to the SOP.
- Championships/Tournaments in MCO areas according to the 'Sports Bubble' Model is limited to the Malaysian Football League (MFL), Malaysian Hockey League (MHL), and the Sepak Takraw League (STL) without the presence of live audiences. Inter-district or interstate travels of athletes, coaches, and sports personnel involved in the tournaments are subject to the approval of PDRM.

### MUSLIM ACTIVITIES IN MOSQUE/SURAU

- Allowed according to the Guidelines issued by State Religious Authorities.
- Islamic wedding ceremonies in the religious department and mosque is allowed with attendance in accordance with the ruling of the State Religious Authority.

### ACTIVITIES IN OTHER RELIGIOUS PLACES

- All other States - subject to the approval of the Ministry of National Unity.
- For Wilayah Persekutuan Kuala Lumpur, Putrajaya, and Labuan - subject to the approval of the Ministry of Federal Territories.
- The registration of marriages for non-Muslims at the National Registration Department (JPN) is allowed with attendance as determined JPN.

### MEETINGS

- Face-to-face meetings of Government and private agencies involving the presence of representatives of external agencies are NOT ALLOWED and can be implemented through video conferencing.

### OTHER ACTIVITIES

- Recreational fishing is allowed during MCO according to the SOP issued by the Department of Fisheries.
- Driving Institutes and Flight Training Centers are allowed to operate during MCO according to the SOP issued by the Ministry of Transport.
- Dine-in at restaurants is allowed according to the capacity of the table with physical distancing of at least 1 metre between customers.

## PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

- Seminars/Workshops/Courses/Training/Conferences Talks/Exhibitions and all related MICE activities.
- Government and private, formal and informal events, and social events.
- Spa and reflexology operations.
- Activities at nightclubs or pubs, theme parks, indoor playgrounds, family karaoke, and cinemas.
- Mass activities.
- Sports activities carried out in facilities/premises with no supervision control.
- Sports tournament/competition activities other than for MFL, MHL, and STL.
- Sports activities carried out outside the movement controlled areas in force unless authorized.
- Outbound/inbound tourism activities in MCO areas and in EMCO areas.
- Overseas tourism activities by citizens and domestic tourism activities involving foreign tourists entering Malaysia except foreign tourists from countries specified by the Minister.
