ACTIVITIES AND PROTOCOLS

PROHIBITED



Nightclubs, Pubs.
Cinemas - **Exception:**
Green zone areas



Concerts or live events with audience

Organising local and international tournaments/competitions **WITHOUT** approval and **WITH** spectators/supporters; Participation of international participants/officers in sport competitions/tournaments **WITHOUT** permission

Mass activities involving the participation of more than 500 people at any one time



PERMITTED

Tourism Activities / Leaving or entering **CMCO** & **RMCO** areas
Exception: **EMCO** areas



Interstate and District Travel
Exception: **EMCO** areas

Schools, Public & Private Institutes of Higher Education, Skills Training Institutes, tahfiz centres, private educational institutions in the category of private kindergartens, schools and centres (such as tuition, Language, skills, mind development and guidance centres) and other educational institutions




Weddings, Parties and Social Gatherings at 50% of the capacity of the premises

All Seminars/Workshops/Courses/Trainings/Conferences/Talks at 50% of the capacity of the premises.



Ongoing Industrial Training is allowed within the respective training institutions only.

The following activities are allowed at 50% of the capacity of the premises:

- Public tourist attraction products, e.g. zoos, farms, aquariums, edutainment centres, recreational parks, extreme / adventure / nature parks and others;
- Art, culture and heritage centres. e.g. museums, libraries, art galleries, cultural and heritage centres / villages, cultural performance stages and others;
- Family Entertainment and Theme parks.





Compulsory to wear a face mask especially in crowded public areas except for the following:


- Private residence involving own household members;
- Hotel room/paid accommodation and involving own household members;
- Isolated work space;
- Indoor and Outdoor sport and recreational activities;
- Private vehicle involving own household members;
- Indoor/Outdoor public areas without the presence of other individuals; and
- While eating and drinking in public areas.



Private vehicle: According to vehicle's capacity

Taxi/e-hailing: According to vehicle's capacity

All public transport



Hospitals and Clinics open 24 hours



Pharmacies from 8am to 12am



Individual and team, indoor and outdoor sports and recreational activities for training, games, matches and tournaments **WITHOUT** spectators.

RT-PCR / RTK Antigen tests must be taken by all participants, officers and reserve players 3 days before the competition date and only participants that test negative may participate in tournaments




Dine-in with 1 metre distance between customers, from 6am to 12am.






Individual with body temperature of more than 37.5 degree celcius is **prohibited** from entering any premises



Food delivery from 6am to 12am

Activities in places of worship are allowed according to the attendance limitations set by respective authorities.

Solemnisation (Muslim) and marriage ceremony (non-Muslim) are allowed with a maximum of 30 guests.


In-person meetings for business/work purposes held in offices, hotels and other institutions in compliance with physical distancing and the mandatory requirement of wearing face masks.



Meeting rooms are allowed to be used at 50% capacity only.

General Hours of Business from 6am to 12am

Provided: Adhere to SOPs such as wearing face masks properly, manual check-in or via MySejahtera App, temperature checks, ensuring that the number of customers are limited and that the maximum number of customers allowed is displayed



Music recordings, concerts, filming, talk shows, live events etc. in recording studios or outdoor with **NO audience**



Indoor busking activities in building premises, cafes, food courts, and non-open locations



Daily markets, Wholesale markets, Farmers' markets, Night markets, late night bazaars and other similar markets are allowed to operate in accordance with their licence/permit until 12am
